Bio

John Browne is an Irish composer working in theatre, opera, and specialising in choral work. Operas include *BABETTE'S FEAST* and *DEMON JUICE* for the Royal Opera House, and *MIDNIGHT'S CHILDREN* and *THE EARLY EARTH OPERAS* for English National Opera. Recent choral work includes music for Westminster Abbey, Choir of King's College London, Southbank Centre and the band Elbow. Theatre work includes creating *THE MOTHER'S RING* a music-theatre piece with survivors of the genocide in Rwanda. In the past three years, *THE EVENTS*, written by David Greig and directed by Ramin Gray, has toured extensively worldwide, and John has just completed work on the team's second collaboration, *THE SUPPLIANT WOMEN*, which opened to critical acclaim in October 2016.
